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#1 INITIAL PLANNING

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Define your budget.

#4 HIRING A BUILDER

Research and shortlist potential builders. Check references and past work. Verify licenses and insurance. Get detailed quotes and compare them. Read and understand the contract before signing.



#5 PERMITS AND APPROVALS

Submit building plans for approval.
Obtain necessary permits (e.g., building, plumbing, electrical)
Schedule inspections at various stages of construction.
Comply with homeowner association rules (if applicable).



#6 CONSTRUCTION PHASE

Clear and prepare the lot.
Lay the foundation.
Frame the structure.
Install roofing and exterior finishes.
Rough-in plumbing, electrical, and HVAC systems.



#7 INTERIOR FINISHES

Insulate and drywall.
Install windows and doors.
Choose and install flooring.
Paint and finish walls.
Install cabinetry and countertops.



#8 MECHANICAL SYSTEMS

Complete plumbing installations. Finish electrical work (e.g., outlets, fixtures). Install HVAC systems. Test all systems for functionality.



#9 FINAL TOUCHES

Install appliances.
Complete interior trim work.
Lay carpet and other flooring.
Install final fixtures (e.g., faucets, lighting).
Conduct a final walkthrough to check for any issues.





#10 EXTERIOR FINISHES

Landscape the yard. Install driveways and walkways. Set up outdoor living spaces (e.g., patio, deck). Ensure proper drainage and grading. Add exterior lighting and security features.



#11 INSPECTION AND HANDOVER

Schedule a final inspection.
Address any issues or corrections.
Obtain a certificate of occupancy.
Review and receive all warranty documents.
Prepare for the move-in.



#12 POST-CONSTRUCTION

Conduct a final review with the builder. Settle any remaining payments. Familiarize yourself with home maintenance. Plan for future upgrades or modifications. Provide feedback
